## Video peer-modelling script

### Scenario

One of the students is interviewing their friend for their **My strengths** homework task.

Please use this as an example only.

Please adapt to suit your situation so that it appears more natural.

LOUIS: *[Insert friend's name]*, I have a homework task where I have to choose people to interview about my strengths. Will you do it?

FRIEND: Sure.

LOUIS: So, do you know what I mean by a strength?

FRIEND: Um, is it like, something you are good at?

LOUIS: Yeah.

FRIEND: Like basketball?

LOUIS: Um, yeah, but I'd like something that I can relate to my career choices.

FRIEND: OK, well, you might become a professional basketballer.

LOUIS: That's true but it's not very likely.

FRIEND: Can it be like a personality thing?

LOUIS: Sure, our teacher said it could be a personality thing, or a skill, or a knowledge base.

FRIEND: OK, then I'd have to say your personality, that you are really easy-going and friendly.

LOUIS: That's a nice thing to say. Can you give me an example?

FRIEND: Well, like when Josh came to our class and he was really nervous and you decided that you would show him around and be a friend.

LOUIS: Oh yeah, I remember, OK , I've written that down, now I have to find someone else. Thanks mate.
