

# Teacher notes: Journal writing

## For all work experience levels

myWAY Employability encourages students to maintain a journal **before**, **during**, and **after** their work experience.

We have provided some writing prompts for you to provide to students who need this kind of support with writing.

For some students, a photographic diary may be a good option.

Print the second page of the student's journal "*During work experience*" for each day that the student attends work experience.

We recommend that you read your student's work experience journal each week to track your student's progress.
